

Celebrate Broadway



THE QUINCY SYMPHONY Chorus will present *Celebrate Broadway* Saturday, **March 1**, at 7:30 p.m. at the First Union Congregational Church, 105 North 12th Street, Quincy. Former Quincyan Brad Tomko will join Dr. Phyllis Robertson and the chorus in a performance of favorite songs from Broadway musicals. Works will be accompanied by a combo of piano, bass and drums.

Tomko is a 1984 graduate of Quincy High School and attended Quincy University before setting out on his solo career. He is known here in Quincy for his lead performances in the Quincy High School musicals at that time. He will sing a selection of hits from famous Broadway

musicals including *Phantom of the Opera* and *West Side Story*.

The Symphony Chorus medley will touch on over 40 popular songs from 100 years of Broadway history including *Give My Regards to Broadway*, *Hello, Dolly!*, *Oh What a Beautiful Mornin'* and *Sweeney Todd*. They will perform *Les Miserables Medley* arranged by Ed Lojeski including the favorites *Bring Him Home*, *I Dreamed a Dream* and *On My Own*.

Tickets are \$15 for adults, \$12 for senior citizens and free for children under the age of 18 and are available at the door or in advance from Wild Birds Unlimited, 3502 Broadway, or by calling the symphony office @ 222-2856.
